



Cooperation Agreement
between
the Georgian Association of Medical Specialties
and
the Polish Supreme Chamber of Physicians and Dentists

The Polish Supreme Chamber of Physicians and Dentists (Naczelna Izba Lekarska), the organisational body of the professional self-government of physicians and dentists in Poland, and the Georgian Association of Medical Specialties (*name of the Association in Georgian language*), in order to establish and strengthen cooperation and to support common activities, on 14 September 2012 conclude the following agreement:

§ 1.

The Parties of the Agreement shall cooperate in particular by:

1. exchanging information regarding the policies and activities of both Parties and sharing experiences;
2. providing information on the domestic and international conferences, symposia and meetings organized by both Parties – representatives of the other Party may be delegated to attend these events;
3. collaborating in the field of health policies and exercise of the medical profession;

4. sharing information regarding the journals published by the Parties and about the publication possibilities;
5. providing on each Party's website information regarding the collaboration with the other Party (including the other Party's logo and link to its website).

§ 2.

Representatives of the Parties shall meet in order to discuss the issues specified in advance. The meetings shall be carried out by electronic means (teleconferences) and in justified cases physical meetings may be held in Georgia or Poland or on the occasion of an international gathering attended by representatives of both Parties.

§ 3.

The Agreement is concluded for an indefinite period.

§ 4.

The Agreement may be terminated by either Party giving a 3 month notice.

§ 5.

Any modifications of the Agreement shall be made in writing.

§ 6.

The Agreement is drawn up and signed in two, equally authentic, language versions – in Georgian and in Polish.

§ 7.

The Agreement comes into force on the day of its signing by the Parties.
